Come see us at Trunk or Treat in downtown Chadron Friday, October 25th and will run from 5-7 PM. Volunteers and candy donations are very much appreciated!

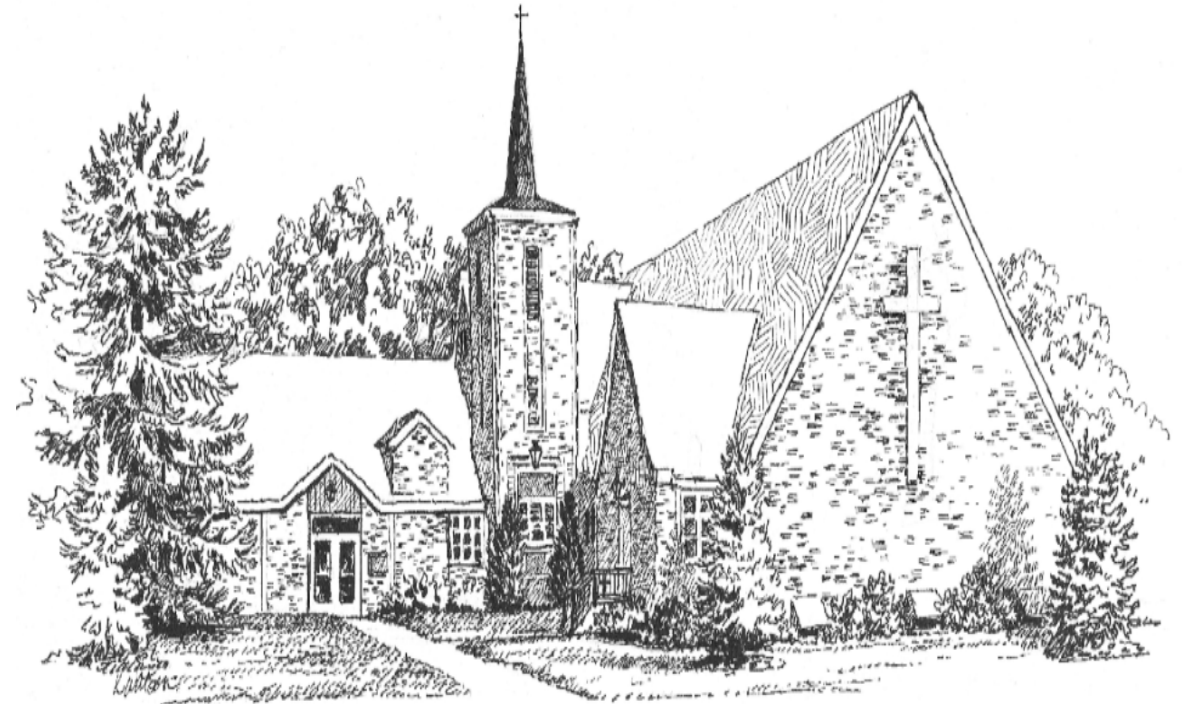
United Methodist Men will meet Sunday, October 20th, 5:30 PM at Country Kitchen
